How it Works

It begins when you click on a student profile to learn more about each child. After reading different profiles, you decide who to partially or fully sponsor.

When a student is fully

funded, money is channeled to our local partners across the globe, who disburse the funding after they check up on the students, their families, and their schools. In essence, funding is directly transferred from your wallet into the hands of students across the world to offset tuition and school expenses...and to bring hope of a better future.

Become a Donor

- 4. Select the amount you would like to donate (as little as \$5)

Speed, Ease, Transparency

Once you have chosen your student or project, making the actual donation takes only five minutes. After your student or project has been fully funded, funds are quickly dispersed and you will start receiving monthly updates from our field partners on how your money has been used. You even can send messages to your student through Givology's website. At Givology, it's about **direct connections**—not red tape.

Choice

Online, you will find detailed profiles of each student or project. It is up to you to decide what kind of impact your donation will make. You can even see a breakdown of how exactly the money will be spent - for example, \$125 on tuition and \$30 on textbooks. In addition, it is completely up to you to choose the size of your donation, which can be as small as \$5.

Collective Impact

\$5 - isn't that about the price of a coffee at Starbucks? If ten people gave up their daily dose of caffeine for one week, that would total \$350 - that's more than enough tuition, textbooks, and school supplies for one student. Imagine if your tuition could be reduced with such a simple sacrifice.





What makes Givology different

Where does Givology currently operate?

Givology is incorporated in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, but our staff presence extends across the globe. Our field operations are currently limited to rural China but we are already actively researching and making contact with potential field partners in other developing countries in preparation for expansion worldwide in the medium to long run.

How can I track the progress of a student or project?

Our partners are our eyes, ears, nose, and mouth. They are the ones who directly link Givology users to sponsored students. Thus,





to us. Generally, student and project updates are collected monthly by Givology field partners and then posted online to be shared with the donors supporting the student or project.

What happens when a student is fully funded?

When a student is fully-funded, we make arrangements to transfer the funding to our partner organization. In addition, we send the student a welcome package including a letter introducing Givology and all the donors who have helped sponsor him or her, as well as all the printed messages that donors have sent to him or her through our messaging system. Through our inbox system, we will notify donors that his or her sponsored student is fully-funded, and then request that the donor submit a message to the student before a deadline, if he or she desires to.
